Mike Linares wins 7th Iron Thong Tournament

But the low clouds overhead held onto their moisture long enough for 35 erstwhile Iron Thongers to complete their rounds. The big winner, and newly-crowned King Thong, was Mike Linares, the first player to emerge from the C Flight to take overall honors in ITG history. When the counting was done, Mike had parred the number one handicap hole to claim the Iron Thong Traveling Trophy.
